Kueber succeeding Bartlett at Durham firm

Scientific Properties COO Tucker Bartlett is stepping down and will be succeeded by Dr. Gary Kueber, who has served as a director of the real estate development firm.

Bartlett has been named executive vice president at **Self-Help Credit Union**, where he worked prior to joining Scientific Properties. In his new role, he will oversee Self-Help's commercial lending and commercial real estate investment activities. Bartlett was named COO in 2008 when Scientific Properties' president, Andrew Rothschild, relocated to New York City.

"Tucker has done an outstanding job over the last two years at the helm of Scientific Properties," Rothschild said in a news release. "Gary has been Tucker's valued partner every step of the way, and under his new leadership we look forward to a future of great new projects for Durham."

As COO, Kueber will oversee the company's operations and portfolio of projects that includes a development pipeline of more than 2 million square feet in downtown Durham, including the Venable Center office and retail property and the Golden Belt mixed-use property.

A native of New Orleans, Kueber moved to Durham in 1997 and practiced medicine until 2004, when he returned to graduate school and master's degrees in public health and regional planning from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He joined Scientific Properties in 2007.
